These materials can be used in a wide range of circumstances, and can be included in trainings. The especially good thing about them is that they allow the participant more individual input and can provide back-up and self-help further practice, and be referred to as required in the long-term.

A further advantage is that there are listening tasks and short tests in the programme.

In trainings, it would be helpful that participants have access to computers and internet - at least enough for two participants - something that is actually preferable due to the fact that together in pairs cooperative learning is guaranteed. Additionally, audio speakers are also required.
